### Residential Mandatory Measures Storm Water Pollution Prevention Requirements CERTIFICATION OF COMPLIANCE

*(California Green Code - Chapter 4 (Division 4.1 – Planning and Design))*

**NOTICE:** If your project will require the clearing and grubbing of one acre or more; or you grade, fill, excavate, store or dispose of 350 cubic yards or more of soil or earthy material on the site; or your project is part of a larger common plan of development, this certification document does not apply. In addition to a building permit, you must obtain a separate Grading Permit for your project from the County of Sacramento. For projects that do not fall within the above requirements, this “certification of compliance” document, shall be included with all “new building” residential permit applications and plan submittals.

By signing this document, you are certifying that you, as the permit holder (OWNER, CONTRACTOR or RESPONSIBLE PARTY) and all parties working under this permit, will comply with the provisions of the Residential Mandatory Site Development requirements contained in the California Green Code. You further certify that you will install and maintain storm water pollution prevention Best Management Practices (BMPs) and control discharges from your site. Failing to comply with the County “Storm Water Management and Discharge Control” ordinance, could in fact result in your project receiving a “Notice to Comply”, a “Notice of Violation”, a “Stop Work Order” and/or administrative civil penalty of up to five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) per day for each violation. (See Sacramento County Code – Chapter 15.12, Section 15.12.560). These actions and penalties are exclusive of any potential additional State imposed enforcement for non-compliance.

*In addition to the provided information in the entitled “CALGreen Requirements for Small Residential Development” pamphlet, “The Sacramento Storm Water Management Program pamphlet entitled “Construction on Small Building Sites” describes methods for protecting your site and includes an example site plan for managing Storm Water on your small construction project.*

Typical storm water Best Management Practices (BMPs) that will be inspected include (but are not limited to):

- Storm Drain Inlet Protection
- Perimeter Protection
- Erosion Control (covering exposed soil)
- Tracking Control / Stabilized Entry
- Stockpile Management
- Containment of Concrete Waste
